Subject: Sewage Spill

To the GPOA Board:

Yesterday, the IJ reported of a sewage spill in Kentfield from last Saturday. We did not learn about it until we read the article, so staff is still trying to get information from all local agencies involved.

I have been told there should be no swimming in the creek for a couple of months. I don't have clarification on the health issues of being on the creek, i.e. in small water crafts.

The rains this week may have diluted the sewage to some degree. Until we find out the level of contaminants and bacteria that remains in the water, I would advise that you and your pets do not go into or on the water.

My e-mail list is not that comprehensive. Your residents are not on the creek, but please forward this to others you know to be recreational users of the creek and especially to any household who live directly adjacent to the creek.
