8:15 Highway 101 Greenbrae/Twin Cities Corridor Project Draft Initial Study



The project area is from SFD at Eliseo Drive in Greenbrae to the Tamalpais/Paradise intersection and will affect residents of Kentfield and Greenbrae. The KPAB should review main points of the proposed project and consider requesting a full-scale EIR to evaluate the potential impacts of this project rather than rely solely on the initial study and mitigated negative declaration.
